## SEX AND RELATIONSHIPS EDUCATIONS (SRE)

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to inform you of the particular areas that we will be focusing on in Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) during this term (**Wc. 24<sup>th</sup> June**). This may help you prepare for the possible questions or topics that your child might wish to discuss with you at home. SRE is a part of our Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education (PSHE) Curriculum taught throughout the school.

In year 6, children will be learning about:

- Gender Stereotypes – sexual orientation
- Online technology safety: Social networking and sending pictures
- Relationships: Peer pressure
- Feelings: Talking to people about how we feel
- Keeping safe: Good touch and bad touch
- Life cycles: How babies are made – sexual intercourse
- Life cycles: How babies are made – assisted fertility
- Life cycles: Multiple births
- Life cycles: how babies are born

To support work in class we will be using the FPA 'Growing up with Yasmine and Tom' classroom resources. We will also be watching DVD materials from Channel 4's 'Living and Growing' series. If you would like to view any of these materials we will be holding an open session for parents on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June at 4.45** in the Silverthorne Building. Unfortunately it will not be possible for children or younger siblings to attend this session.



If you do wish to attend this session then please complete the attached slip and return to your class teacher.

Parents can withdraw their child from the parts of Sex and Relationship Education (SRE) which currently fall outside the national Curriculum. Any parent wishing to withdraw their child should discuss this with the class teacher in the first instance and then in writing to the Headteacher by **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2019**.

If you withdraw your child, the child will be provided with related work and sent to an alternative class when certain elements of the SRE topic are being taught.
