Following the success of last year's Year 6 Camp to PGL Osmington Bay, we have made a provisional booking for the residential trip from Monday 28th September – Friday 2nd October 2020. As well as providing children with one of their most treasured memories of primary school, the purpose of the Year 6 camp is to enable children to develop their skills of independence and team building, fostering a greater sense of unity among the children. These skills are invaluable to children and benefit them not only in their last year at Bishop Road but also in their successful transition to secondary school.

Osmington Bay is situated on the coast and the centre has direct access to a stunning pebble beach as well as boasting an impressive range of indoor and outdoor activities, including water sports at the 2012 Olympic water sports venue around the coast in Weymouth. The centre is set in beautiful, secure grounds with first class instructors and excellent catering. The school is unable to make a loss or a profit on a trip, therefore for this trip to be viable we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £392.72. If sufficient contributions are not received the trip may be cancelled. In order to secure your child's place a non-refundable deposit of £50 is required by **Friday February 14th 2020**. The final amount will be due by Friday 3rd July. Arrangements have been made in the school office if you would like to pay in the following instalments:

Please pay online if possible. You can also give permission for your child to attend online. Alternatively, please enclose the amount as cash or cheque (payable to Bishop Road School) with the attached reply slip.

If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium, you can pay 50% of the contribution – in this case £196.36. No child will be individually excluded from this opportunity for financial reasons. If for financial reasons you feel you are unable to make the contribution, please contact the office, who will make an appointment for you with the Head of Year who will discuss the matter further in the strictest confidence. If at all possible, please make contact before Thursday 13th February. Whilst we realise that circumstances change for some parents, it is unlikely that school can manage effective financial support if discussions occur late.

In the summer term, there will be an information evening organised to give further details and answer any questions you may have.
