## Updated DfE information for parents

## Meals/Vouchers

You may have seen that the government have announced ongoing support for children who are entitled to free school meals through the benefit system. This is different from the universal free school meal programme for all children under 7. We have confirmed with the Local Authority that from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April we will be joining the supermarket voucher scheme that you might have read about. All families that are eligible should have been contacted by the school office to organise this. The current arrangement for meal collections will continue until the voucher scheme begins.

## Home learning

The home learning section of the website will continue to be updated every week. We appreciate many families will choose how they organise this period of home learning during school closure and may run a different timetable in the next couple of weeks as this would normally have been the Easter break. We are also aware that many families value the routine of daily tasks and will choose to continue with this pattern largely unchanged.

New home learning resources in preparation for next week commencing Monday 6th April are available from this afternoon on the school website. We trust that the children will enjoy the new <u>research project about British wildlife</u>. You will notice that there is now a dedicated home learning page, with further guidance and activities, and accessible via the school website home page. We have also begun to create videos to demonstrate some key methods used in maths. Over the coming weeks, we will continue to develop this area of our home learning provision.
