School meals

PE lessons begin the week commencing Monday 7th September

Please support us by sending your child into school with the correct PE kit:

- T-shirt/tracksuit bottoms and t-shirt
- Jumper in colder weather

***Arriving in PE kit**

To support the children being able to enjoy the maximum possible time for PE lessons, we ask that children from the following year groups come to school wearing their PE kits on the following days:

Reception: Tuesday and Thursday

Year 1: Tuesday only

Year 2: Wednesday and Thursday

Children should bring their school uniform with them in their bag to change into afterwards. These lessons are at the start of the day, so the children will spend the vast majority of the day in uniform.

Reception children will begin PE from Monday 21st September.
