## **Update Letter**

## **COVID Symptom Study**

Bishop Road Primary is participating in the Covid Symptom Study to help make sure our students are as safe as possible and to support the scientific dataset of COVID-19 in children.

We are inviting parents and carers to join the Covid Symptom Study now, by downloading the free app and taking less than 1 minute a day to report how your child/children are feeling each day. The information you report will be helpful to scientific research into Covid in children and for public health purposes. The app is available to download from the <a href="Apple App Store">Apple App Store</a> and <a href="Google Play Store">Google Play Store</a>. Simply create a profile for yourself and for your child/children. To join our school network in the app and receive personalised Covid insights about our school, go to Edit Profile for your child's profile > School Network > enter our school's Unique School Network Code (see below) > select the Bubble that your child belongs to.

• Our Unique School Network Code is **AVHIKK6**. To avoid outsiders joining, please do not share this code with anyone who is not a parent of our school.

## **Road Safety**

The large numbers of people around the site makes road safety a priority. We will be talking to the children about road safety again next week in assembly and ask that parents and carers are mindful of parking safely and legally around the school site. Following a visit from Bristol City Council, we understand there are plans to clamp down on illegal and dangerous parking in particular on Clevedon Road by the side of the prison. Please support us by parking safely and legally at drop off and collection. The Road Safety Department are willing to staff and fund multiple crossing patrol officers for our school but have not been able to appoint to these roles. If you are interested, or know anyone who is, please contact the school office for more information.

## Other news & reminders

As you will be aware, Ofsted, whilst not undertaking inspections at this time, are visiting schools to gather sector wide information about school responses to Covid 19. - Please do not come to the school office unless you have a pre-arranged meeting.
- Ensure your child has what they need for the day and do not bring in any items late.
