We are looking forward to children returning to school having enjoyed a very timely and valuable INSET day in which, amongst other things, we welcomed (virtually) a speaker to explore and develop approaches around resilience and well-being for staff and children.

During half-term I contacted two further classes to inform them of the need to self-isolate. The advice provided to school earlier in October by the Health Protection Team [here](#) has not changed. I would ask that, if you did not view this last term, you take the time to do so.

The need for classes to move quickly to remote education is likely to continue and we are greatly appreciative of the overwhelming majority of families who have taken time to ensure they are set up and ready for this eventuality. Please email the info address or call the school office if you need any support with this.

With the second lockdown commencing later this week, we are mindful of the need to be particularly focused on how to limit transmission in our large school community which includes people with a range of vulnerabilities. In addition to **strictly observing the guidance around social distancing** we ask that you adhere to the following:

- Please notify us of covid related absences before 8 am each day via info@bishoproadschool.co.uk
- When you receive a negative test result please let us know before your child arrives back at school.
- Any notifications regarding collections for medical appointments should be sent through 24 hours in advance to the info email address. Staff will bring your child to the black main entrance gates (off Bishop Rd) at the specific time to reduce visitors entering the buildings.
- Please do not come to the school office unless you have a pre-arranged meeting.
- Ensure your child has what they need for the day and do not bring in any items late.
