Remote Education Update

This week, children have begun to complete the stand alone learning tasks, which will have familiarised them with the Class Dojo platform. On Monday 11th January, we will commence our remote education provision for Term 3. Please find below information regarding the structure, timing and content.

• Timetable

At 7pm each Sunday, families will be able to view a <u>weekly timetable</u> outlining the subjects that will be covered and suggested timings for each lesson.

In addition, every evening at 7pm, a <u>daily planning sheet</u> will be available that will give further detail regarding the specific learning objectives and tasks for each day.

• Video materials

From 8.30 am each morning, you will be able to view <u>teacher led videos</u> to guide children's learning in selected subject areas.

• Supporting materials

Alongside the videos, you will see a range of supporting materials to aid the completion of set tasks. These may include <u>writing support sheets</u>, <u>PowerPoint slides</u> and <u>links to additional videos</u>. For particular lessons where an outcome sheet may support the completion of the task, optional, printable <u>worksheets</u> will be available. It is however, perfectly acceptable for children to work on plain or lined paper as we recognise families may not have access to a printer or may prefer not to print additional sheets.



• Teacher feedback

Each day, following your child's completion of the day's tasks, please scan or photograph work and **upload it to the portfolio section of your child's Class Dojo account**. *You must be logged on to your child's account to access the portfolio*. A teacher from your child's year group will provide feedback.

• Daily class Zoom

An invitation for the <u>daily class Zoom</u> will be published on Class Dojo, it will appear as an 'Upcoming Event' on the right-hand side of the Class Story page. These daily sessions will include opportunities to interact with their teacher; show some of the things that they have been enjoying or are proud of and share some time together with children from their class. **Daily sessions will begin on Tuesday 12th January** at staggered times throughout the school day. The Zoom invitation will be uploaded by 7pm on the Monday.

• Assemblies

From next week, assemblies and a selection of other stand-alone videos made by teachers, will be available on the main school website (e.g. Cooking with Mr Barr or A Story with Mr Emissah).

• Communication

If you have questions regarding remote education, please contact us via the year group emails. The teachers leading remote learning will respond as soon as possible, we aim to do this within two working days.
