## School Closure Information

Following the Prime Minister's announcement this evening, school will remain closed tomorrow, Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January, until further notice. In the coming days, as the government release further information to schools to confirm their guidance, we will commence provision for children of Critical Workers and Vulnerable Children. We hope that this will be achievable as early as Wednesday or Thursday this week and will update you as soon as we are able. From tomorrow, Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January, all children should commence home learning via Class Dojo. No children should attend school on Tuesday.

This week, home learning will follow the format that was introduced last term for children that were absent for isolation, with pre-set lessons based around subjects and topics that children would have been studying in school this term. This is available via the Class Dojo platform by 9 am tomorrow morning. Please begin with the lessons for Term 3 Day 1. Before the end of this week, once we have assessed the level of staffing required to deliver onsite learning to children of Critical Workers and Vulnerable Children, we will move to a more interactive model of home learning with regular zoom sessions, daily videos for lessons and feedback from teachers.


