Reading - 30 minutes

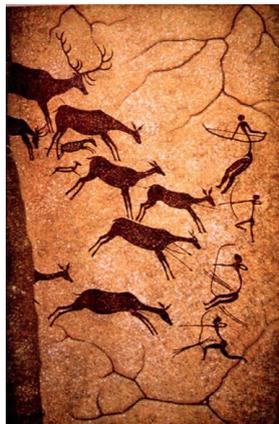
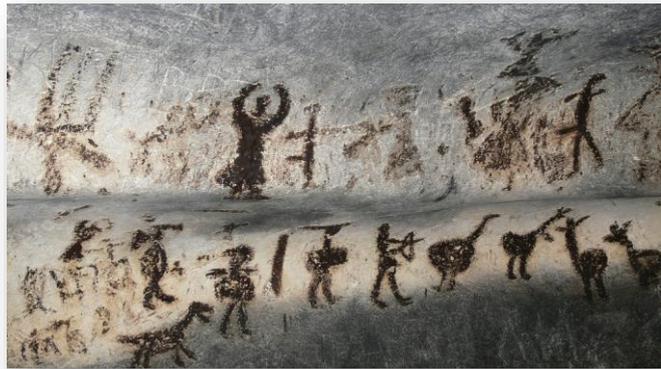
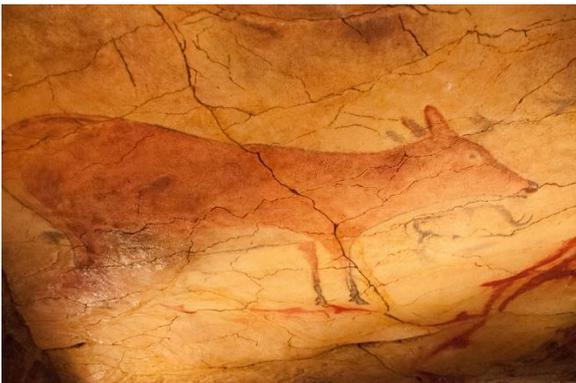
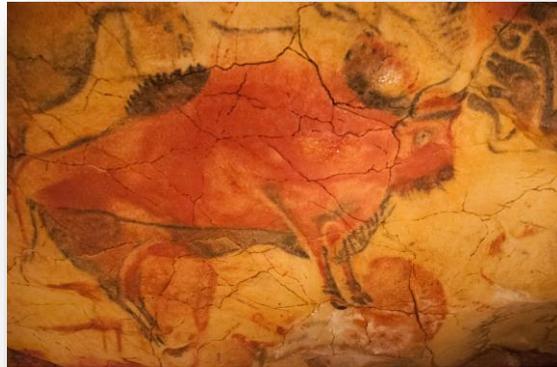
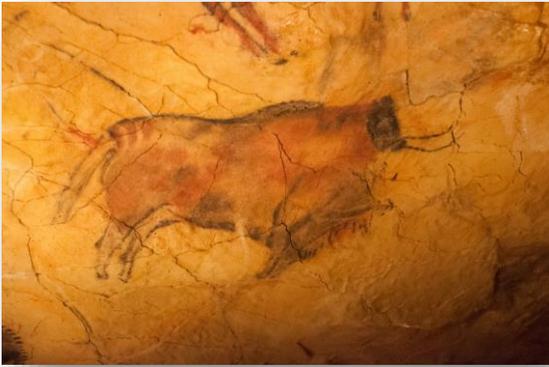
Enjoy spending half an hour doing some reading. You could read to yourself or to somebody else, or perhaps a mixture of both!

History 30-45 minutes

Our history topic this term is the Stone Age. One of the things left over from this time period, from which historians have learnt a great deal, is cave paintings. These were often of animals, hunters, or hand prints, but could be of a whole range of different things.



Your task is to create your own cave painting. People living in the Stone Age would have used natural minerals which they could find around where they lived, but you can use whatever you like that creates colours such as red, brown, orange or black. Suggestions might include paints, colouring pencils/crayons, soil, tea bags, coffee grinds, food colouring - whatever is available to you.
