


Year 3 remote learning - Day 2 Term 3

English - 45 minutes

In Year 3, we are reading *The Abominables* as our novel in English! You might recognise this extract from the first chapter:



A beautiful young girl called Lady Agatha Farlingham was sleeping peacefully in a tent pitched on a ledge below the summit of a mountain known as Nanvi Dar.

Beside her, wearing a green woolly nightcap against the bitter cold, slept her father, the Earl of Farley, and in another tent close by slept their three porters, tough natives of the Himalayas, who carried their baggage and looked after them.

The Earl had come to the roof of the world to search for rare and unknown plants which grew only in these high and dangerous places. He was a famous plant hunter and he liked his daughter Agatha too much to leave her at home in England doing all the boring things that girls had to do in those days, like painting pictures of ruins, or taking walks with their governess, or visiting the poor, who often preferred to be left alone.

You are going to write a letter from the Earl of Farley to a colleague back home in England. You are going to report on the amazing new plant discoveries you have made in the Himalayas. You are welcome to do some research about Himalayan plants or flowers if you want to, or you can make up completely plants or flowers!

For example:

Dear Lord Poshington,

My word old chap, you wouldn't believe the discoveries I've made already up on these snowy slopes! On the very first day, I came across an odd little shrub with purple flowers and leaves shaped like spatulas. It also had a peculiar aroma, like a cross between strawberries and badger dung. I've decided to name it 'The Smelly Purple Strawberry' - imaginative, I know!

And so on - be as creative as you like with the plants that have been discovered! Also, try to be a little posh if you can - he is an Earl after all!

Maths - 30 to 45 minutes

We are now using the column method for solving subtraction sums, and need to be confident taking away a 3-digit number from another 3-digit number by the end of Year 3.
