Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to confirm that we have made a booking at Dean Fields Studies Centre for a residential visit for the current Year 5 children in October 2023. As has been the case for the last couple of years, children will be visiting for half of the school week, with two classes going from Monday to Wednesday and two classes going from Wednesday to Friday.

Dates:

5M and 5D – Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023 to Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October 2023

5L and 5E – Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October to Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2023

As well as providing children with one of their most treasured memories of primary school, the purpose of the Year 6 camp is to enable children to develop their skills of independence and team building. These skills are invaluable to children and benefit them in their successful transition to secondary school.

Dean Field Studies Centre is situated at Parkend in the Forest of Dean. There are many exciting activities, which the children will have the opportunity to try out on the well-equipped site. As this is a smaller centre, we will be the only school there throughout the week and will have sole use of the accommodation and on-site catering. The cost of the trip is £174.54. Payment and permission should be made via School Gateway. Payment in cash can be made at the office (correct amounts only)



In order to secure your child's place, a non-refundable deposit of £50 is required by **Friday April 21<sup>st</sup> 2023**. Further instalments will be due as follows, with the final instalment due by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July:

- Friday May 5<sup>th</sup> – £41.51
- Friday June 9<sup>th</sup> – £41.51
- Friday July 7<sup>th</sup> – £41.52

If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium, the school will fund 50% of the cost of this trip, therefore you will pay £87.27.

If you have financial difficulty with making a payment, please contact the office who will arrange for a member of the Senior Leadership Team to discuss this with you in confidence. Whilst payment is voluntary, schools are unable to make a profit or a loss on trips and activities so require payment or early contact in order to ensure that these activities are able to take place.

As in previous years, we hope to be able to hold an information evening for parents/carers to give further details and answer any questions you may have. This will most likely happen in the summer term.

Many thanks for your continued support and we hope as many children as possible are able to attend the residential trip.
