Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Day

I am writing to you about the arrangements for this year's Sports Day. Similar to previous years, Sports Day will take place in year groups. Spectators are welcomed and very much encouraged. As previously sent out on the date list, Sports Days will take place for the different year groups as follows:-

Year 1 and 2: Tuesday 6th June

Year 3 and 4: Wednesday 7th June

Reception: Thursday 8th June

Year 5 and 6: Friday 9th June

The children will arrive at the field for 1.15pm and the **activities will start at 1.30pm**. Spectators will be able to come onto the field from 1pm. Access to the field will be from the Fenton Road entrance. We anticipate the **activities will finish around 3.15pm** from which pupils can be dismissed directly from the field. Those children not dismissed directly from the field will walk back to school with their class teacher to be dismissed per the normal arrangements. Parental support to help tidy up and clear away at the end was very much appreciated in previous years and I would be grateful if some parents would be willing to help with this again.

Sports Day activities will be focused around the running track and there will be some limited seating for spectators. There will be a short drinks break approximately half way through the activities - the PTFA have kindly offered to provide drinks but **children must bring their own drinks bottle** in order to help reduce the amount of waste plastic we are producing. There will also be a race for parents so get practising! Each class will need two or three parents to support the event on the day with walking the children to the field and then scoring the competition. If you are able to help with either task, please indicate on the attached slip and return it to the office or a teacher. Please note that scoring the races would not prevent you from watching races for the year group your child is in, as the idea is that you score for the other year group e.g. parents from Year 5 score the Year 6 races and vice versa. We very much hope the children find Sports Day to be an enjoyable and worthwhile experience.
