## Kit List

*No bedding is required – this is all provided by Dean Field Study Centre.*

### **Clothing:**

- At least three additional sets of clothes on top of what the children are wearing on the first day (one each for the second and third days and a spare change). This should include:
  - Long sleeved tops/jumpers/t-shirts
  - Full length trousers/joggers/tracksuit bottoms/waterproof trousers – the centre advises against jeans
  - A waterproof coat
  - Plenty of socks and underwear – some thick socks if possible to wear inside wellies
  - At least one additional set of sturdy footwear e.g. trainers, walking shoes
  - Consider hat, gloves etc. if the forecast is cold and wet
  - Wellies if you have them – the centre has a large supply if you don't
- You may also want to pack a couple of pieces of 'indoor' clothing for children to wear during their free time and in the evenings.
- Pyjamas/night attire

*Some activities will be wet and muddy, so try to avoid your favourite, brand-new, expensive clothes and trainers!*

### **Personal care:**

- A towel
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush etc.)
- Sunhat
- Hair ties for long hair – many activities will require long hair to be tied back
- Jewellery cannot be worn for activities

### **Additional:**

- A sturdy water bottle that doesn't leak
- A bin bag or similar for wet/muddy clothes to travel home in

### **Optional:**

- Torch
- Books, board game, notebook, sketchbook, pencils etc. for free time
- A rucksack to use as a day bag
